

2.10 Student Ministry Intern Job Description

Objective:

The main objective of the 2.10 Student Ministry Summer Internship is to provide practical experience in the area of student ministry. Interns will have opportunities including, but not limited to: preparing for and teaching large and small groups, mentoring students, serving daily and on trips, leading in a variety of ways, planning and executing events, and etc. Along with this objective, it is also the intern's job to set an above-reproach example for our students that embodies Christ.

Weekly Responsibilities:

- Praying regularly for students
- Ministering to students
- Working on tasks diligently
- Personal growth spiritually
- Helping plan and implement events
- Gain experience in ministry

Time Commitments:

- Office hours will be determined by the 2.10 Student Ministry Team with the Summer Calendar in mind.
- Interns will attend Super Summer, Mission Trips, Base Camp, and other weekly student events.
- On a normal week expect to work 40+ hours a week. (MTWRSu)
- Wednesday and Sundays are a part of this 40+ hour time.
- If you have a desire to be off in the summer, plan in advance. Remember, this is your summer job and internship and we expect this to be your first priority.

Requirements:

Spirituality:

- Desire to set an example for others and ALWAYS be above reproach.
- Be considering the call to vocational ministry (internship is not limited to people called)
- Demonstrate integrity in all situations and at all times.
- Have a strong desire to serve students.

Transportation and Insurance:

- Have a vehicle
- Have both health and car insurance.
 - Proof of these insurances will be kept on file at the church.

Housing and Meals:

- Any meals on a normal work day and outside of student events will be paid by the intern.
- Interns whose families are local are responsible for their own summer housing.
- Interns that are not local will be housed with a host home from First Baptist Church Lewisville.

As this will be a compensated internship, we desire all applicants to understand that the summer is about servanthood and learning ministry; not just the compensation. The descriptions above are not limited to the job during the summer. Questions or concerns should be asked in applicant's interview or before the completion of application.
