

# Super Summer 2018

**June 11-15 at Hardin Simmons University**

*You are invited to grow and be challenged this summer by participating in Super Summer!*

**From Super Summer:** We are a teaching ministry hidden in a camp. We support churches by teaching students to know and share the gospel. Super Summer invites students who:

- Have declared Jesus Christ as their Savior and Lord.
- Want to know the gospel.
- Want to be burdened for the lost.
- Want to seek opportunities to share the gospel with those around them.
- Are prepared to fully participate in all sessions and activities in the active and highly-disciplined schedule of Super Summer.

## **2.10 Super Summer Participant Requirements:**

- You must have completed the 7<sup>th</sup> grade and not older than a college Freshman by June 11.
- You must be a member of FBC Lewisville
- You must be active in the student ministry (attend Livewire Bible Study, participate in Summit and/or Choir)
- Attend Basecamp (July 10-14)
- Complete the Super Summer Interview Application
- Complete Super Summer Registration Paperwork and Online Registration
- Recite the assigned memory verse(s)

## **Important Dates:**

- March 25<sup>th</sup>—Application, Registration Form, and \$100 non-refundable deposit due
- May 20<sup>th</sup>—Remainder of payment due
- May 20<sup>th</sup>—Memory Verse Due

*The total cost for Super Summer is \$299. Because our student ministry and church believes that Super Summer is an important training camp for students, we are helping to cover some of the cost based on students meeting certain requirements.*

- **Total Students pay**
  - \$150--Deposit (\$100) plus \$50
    - Application and Registration Paperwork is turned in by March 25<sup>th</sup>
    - Online Registration is completed by March 30
    - Memory Verse recited by May 20<sup>th</sup>
    - Signed up for Basecamp by May 20<sup>th</sup>
  - \$300—Deposit (\$100) plus \$200
    - Application and Registration Paperwork is completed by April 30<sup>th</sup>
      - April 30<sup>th</sup> Qualifies for “regular registration” thus the increase

## **Guidelines from Super Summer From Texas Baptists**

1. Students are not allowed off campus. Students must remain on campus from the time of registration on Monday (12:30 PM - 2:00 PM) until checkout on Friday (12:00 PM).
2. Late arrivals and/or early checkouts are not permitted.
3. Students are not allowed to ride in or on any vehicle. For safety, everyone will walk while at Super Summer. Administrative Staff will make use of golf carts in order to better serve students' needs and to facilitate quick arrival in emergency situations.
4. Students must attend all scheduled activities.
5. Students who are ill or injured must stay in the Super Summer Medical Clinic (or hospital). Ill or injured students must seek medical assistance in the Super Summer Medical Clinic (or hospital) until they are able to return to regularly scheduled activities with their school. In the event of illness or injury, students may not remain in their dorms.
6. Students must indicate which medications they will use at Super Summer; medications will not be shared. All medications should be listed on the health form.
7. Medications should be submitted to the Super Summer Medical Staff upon arrival.
8. Students must be in their dorm each night by 10:30 PM. Lights will go out at 11:00 PM. Curfew applies to all Students and Team Leaders. Dorms will lock at 10:30 PM.
9. Under no circumstances are girls allowed in boys' rooms or boys in girls' rooms. This includes hallways outside the dorm rooms.
10. Drugs, alcohol, any form of tobacco, e-cigarette, vape, any type of paint, firearm, knives, or any other kind of weapon, or explosive is not allowed. Also do not bring any type of cell phone, computers or electronic games or equipment.
11. Clothing should reflect a godly attitude and not divert the attention of others from their focus on God's word and His purpose in their lives. Casual clothing is acceptable during all activities at Super Summer. Sleeveless clothing is not allowed. Shorts, skirts, or dresses must be at least fingertip length. Students wearing inappropriate clothing (i.e., sheer or tight clothing) will be asked to change. Students should wear clothes that will allow them to be comfortable sitting on the ground/in the grass at various times of the day and night.
12. Students must wear name tags above the waist at all times.
13. No Public Displays of Affection.
14. Students must obey university rules and regulations. Super Summer participants will be guests on the university campuses and must abide by their rules and regulations concerning dorms, dining halls, and all other facilities.

\*\*The attendee is a dedicated Christian.

\*\*The attendee commits to attend all school sessions, be on time, and participate in every activity planned for them by Super Summer staff.
